Re: **Your request for the information regarding a domestic dispute and an assault level 1 complaints investigated by York Regional Police**

I am responding to your request for access to information, which has been treated as a request for personal information under the provisions of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. Our file number is 18-0950.

In response to your request for information regarding the above-noted, attached is a copy of the Incident #13-24802 which was a domestic dispute investigated by York Regional Police on January 26, 2013 at 29 Woodhaven Cr; Richmond Hill. Some personal information of persons other than yourself, from whom we do not have consent to release their information has been deleted from the attached records.

The following subsections of the Act, with an explanation of each sub-section, were used to exempt the information:

38(b) Disclosure would constitute an unjustified invasion of another individual's personal privacy because;

14(3)(b) Disclosure of personal information is presumed to constitute an unjustified invasion of personal privacy where the personal information was compiled and is identifiable as part of an investigation into a possible violation of law, except to the extent that disclosure is necessary to prosecute the violation or to continue the investigation. In response to your request for information regarding Mahmoud Bonakdarzadeh and Seyed Reza Ziaei a search of the Information Management database was conducted, the results were negative no information was found.

In response to your request for information regarding the assault level 1 complaint, attached is a summary report for Incident, #18-179253, investigated by York Regional Police on June 09, 2018 at 29 Woodhaven Cr; Richmond Hill.

Our records indicate that criminal code offences have been laid against you in relation to this incident and are currently before the courts. This police service takes the view that any premature disclosure of any further records may interfere with the preparation of the matter for trial.

Access is denied to any further information regarding this incident pursuant to subsection 52(2.1) of the Act:


52(2.1) This act does not apply to a record relating to a prosecution if all proceedings in respect of the prosecution have not been completed.

I wish to advise that there is another avenue for you to pursue. You may contact the Crown Attorney's Office at 905-853-4800, who will advise you of the process for obtaining the disclosure of the records collected in relation to the charges laid against you.

You have 30 days from the date of this letter to make this appeal, which should be made in writing.

If it is your decision to make an appeal, you should provide the Commissioner with our above-noted file number, a copy of this decision letter and a copy of your original request for information. In addition, you must send an appeal fee to the Commissioner's office with your letter of appeal. Because your request was treated as a "personal" request, your appeal fee would be \$10.00, which can be paid by cheque or money order payable to the Minister of Finance.

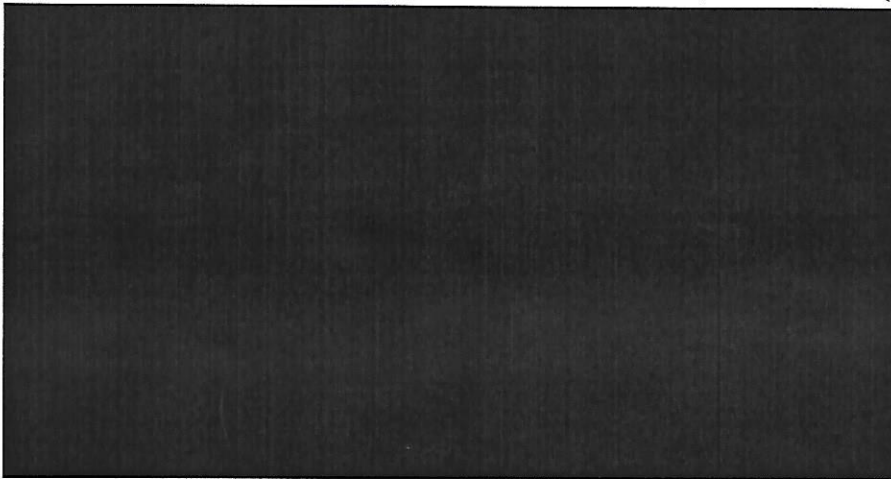

Narrative: INITIAL OFFICER REPORT - 1

Subject: **DOMESTIC DISPUTE**

On the 26 January 2013 at approximately 1437 hours York Regional Police attended 29 Woodhaven Cr in the Town of Richmond Hill in regards to a family domestic.

On arrival officers were met by RADMEHR, Mahyar (husband) and ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI, Sheida (wife), all was calm in the home. The couple have been married since 2007 and have been together a total of 8 years. They have 2 children, a 3 year old and a 1 year old. There have been previous reported domestics in the past between the 2, on one occasion RADMEHR, Mahyar was charged with assault against his wife.

RADMEHR, Mahyar advised he was not allowed in his home 29 Woodhaven Cr from 22 November 2012 till 09 January 2013 as per that assault charge. RADMEHR, Mahyar has recently come home. Since his return home he advises that his wife ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI, Sheida has been acting different and hyper. Today the couple were home together with their children. They are both unemployed. ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI, Sheida had written RADMEHR, Mahyar a \$3000 cheque from her personal savings account. RADMEHR, Mahyar then said for unknown reasons ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI, Sheida became hyper and ripped the cheque out of his hands and ripped it up. The 2 began arguing over the financial issue. ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI, Sheida then went into the safe and took out the children's passports to hide them from him. RADMEHR, Mahyar found this unusual. RADMEHR, Mahyar advised that he called EMS at this point and not police. He said she was very hyper and hoped that EMS could come calm her down and check on her. RADMEHR, Mahyar stated he did not find it necessary for police to be present. RADMEHR, Mahyar stated she may have possible post partum depression.
