


On Sunday January 27th, 2013 at approximately 2059 York Regional Police were dispatched to 29 Woodhaven Crescent in the Town of Richmond Hill regarding a Family Domestic call. The complainant Sheida ALETRATIKHOSROSHAHI (wife) advised that her mother in law (Malahat KHERADYART) was hitting and kicking her.

Upon officers attending the residence both parties were separated. Officers spoke with the parties separately.



The complainant advised that she has been sick over the last few days and hasn't been able to sleep for the last 48hours. On todays date her husband Mahyar RADMEHR took their older child out while she slept for a few hours with the younger child. She stated that her husband returned home and her mother in-law (Malahat) was in their garage. She stated that Malahat started swearing at her and calling her a "WHORE". Sheida continued stating that Malahat doesn't think she can take care of the children. Sheida explained to the officers that Malahat was sitting on the couch with her child. Sheida had told her to get out of their house and tried taking the child from her. Sheida indicated that while attempting to grab the child Malahat pushed her away in the face, and kicked her shin. Sheida stated that she wanted Malahat to leave her house and not to return.

Officers spoke with Mahyar and his mother Malahat. Mahyar advised that he invited his mother to their house to help with their children. He indicated that Sheida has been sick and he needs help taking care of the children. Both Mahyar and Malahat advised that Malahat did not hit Sheida. They advised that Sheida is upset because Sheida believes that they are trying to take away the kids and have her kicked out of the house.



Sheida advised that she does not need help to take care of her


