9. The Respondent claims that I signed the documents in front of Olimpia Gilmour. I did not. In any event, I have found documents that show that the Royal Bank increased the line of credit to \$650,000 without my involvement, even though the line of credit was, apparently, secured against the matrimonial home. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "G" is a copy of the RBC Homeline Plan Amending Agreement dated January 23, 2017 increasing the line of credit. My signature does not appear anywhere on that document. This shows the increased credit deal was approved without my involvement.

10. The Respondent claims he has only drawn \$108,000 on the line of credit and has no intention of drawing more. If he has no intention of drawing more, he should not object to it being frozen. However, I do not know if he is telling the truth about how much he has drawn on the line of credit. Attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "H" are two line of credit statements from the Royal Bank both for the period of June 30, 2017. These statements strongly suggest that there are 2 lines of credit against the matrimonial home, not just one, and that he has drawn almost the full \$650,000.

11. The Respondent claims he was the more involved parent and says that he can be more involved because he works nights. none of that is true. As stated, I stayed home to raise the girls when they were younger, returning to work part-time in 2015. The Respondent has always been the primary income earner. Furthermore, he works various shifts, not just nights. His shifts change from night to day every couple of months. Furthermore, he changes jobs often and these shifts are only at his current job. The only recreational activity he does with them is bike riding.

12. He saw the girls on Sunday for a visit and I am happy to facilitate more access. However, I do not believe that it is appropriate that they live with him equally. As stated, I have been their primary caregiver and they are used to living in the matrimonial home. While the girls love their father, he is very impatient with them and they have seen his violent temper. They have witnessed him throwing things and breaking objects. They are afraid of him and I do not believe it is in their best interest to suddenly begin living 50% of the time in a new home. I also have serious concerns about the girls living with his younger brother. His younger brother has mental health problems and during the marriage we both agreed that the girls should not be left alone with him. Now the Respondent wants the girls to live under the same roof with his brother. I believe he is requesting this simply because he does not want to pay child support. He already tried to cancel our home phone, internet and my cell phone late last week.


